



Green Tower is a proprietary investment vehicle focused on (co)developing and (co)operating projects and corporates in the renewable energy and associated energy transition sectors. We are co-developers in the sense that we do not aim to take a majority stake and typically support the original developer/entrepreneur with structuring, contracting and financing capabilities. We focus on capital intensive projects, start and scale ups or developers with that profile. Green Tower has a dedicated development and investment team working on solar, onshore and offshore wind and participations in companies. Green Tower is owned by the same shareholders as Green Giraffe, a reputable financial advisory firm, that operates independently from Green Tower.

We are a team of approx. 15 professionals with our main activities in Utrecht (The Netherlands), Paris (France), and Cape Town (South Africa).

As part of our work, we assist our partners with the development of their projects. This includes amongst others negotiations of land contracts, technical design and studies for permit applications, contracting of EPC and O&M contracts, power purchase agreements, and ultimately the financing of the projects.

We currently have a team working full time on the development of ground mounted solar projects in The Netherlands and given our growth we are looking for an associate project developer (2-4 year relevant working experience) to be based in our Utrecht office to strengthen the team.

Position

The scope of this role will include:

- Assisting in or leading the development of renewable energy projects
- Drafting contracts for co-development, land lease, PPAs, etc.
- Sub-contracting and supervising technical advisors
- Ensuring bankability of all permits, consents and contracts of the project
- Applying for permits, feed-in tariffs and/or power purchase agreements
- Assisting in Green Tower's commercial efforts regarding project development work

You would report to the project development coordinator and the investment committee of Green Tower. On individual projects you would be an integral part of our development team and work with the project manager and the project partner. Part of the projects we co-develop are in our growth regions in Belgium, Germany and France so ability and willingness to travel and spend time abroad is a requirement.

You would be part of a unified and close-knit senior team which prides itself on its transparency and proactivity. More generally, the position entails active participation in a young, international and dynamic team focused on making projects happen and could include regular travel within and outside Europe.

Required education and attributes

The candidate should have at master degree in economics, science or a similar relevant qualification. In addition, the candidate should demonstrate:

- At least a basic understanding of – and interest in – financial concepts and products
- At least a basic technical understanding of the working of solar energy
- At least a basic understanding of the legal and commercial aspects of project contracts
- Excellent communication skills (both oral and written) in Dutch and English (a third language such as French or German would be a great plus)
- Experience in using MS Office software, in particular Excel and Word
- Experience in project development or contracting
- Knowledge of technical software like PVSyst is a plus
- Thoroughness, accuracy and organisational skills
- An ability to take initiatives and take responsibility for allocated tasks

Package

This position is offered on a fixed 12 months term starting as soon as practicable, with a competitive compensation package. If conditions permit it, it would be our intention to offer a permanent position to the candidate following the initial 12 months period. The candidate can expect opportunities to travel to visit partners and to participate in regular team building activities.
